

Basic Eligibility Criteria for Admission in BBA

Students who are looking for admission in the BBA department should submit their graduation certificates from the Ministry of Secondary and high school Education in addition to the following documents before taking the entrance exam.

- 12th / 14th Grade Graduation Certificate
- Identity Card (Tazkira)
- Passport size four-piece photos
- Passports and visas for foreign students
- National Examination Authority Registration Form
- Database Registration Form

Semester Rules

The performance of students is evaluated through a continuous testing procedure spread over the entire period of studies. In each semester one mid-term and one final exam are held. Semester system education enables a student to be successful in nowadays fast and challenging world. Students are kept busy and working with constant home assignments, surprise quizzes and several presentations. One of the most important features of semester system is that it is a gradual and systematic way of studying. Each semester leads in to the other; that is, the first semester starts with the basics of courses and slowly the courses become advanced as the semesters move toward the final ones.

a. Attendance

- i. Every student of the Institute is required to maintain at least 75% of the attendance in each course. A student who fails to meet the minimum requirements of attendance in any course will not be allowed to take final examination for that course.
- ii. The 25% margin of absence from the classes is reserved for an illness case or other unavoidable circumstances.
- iii. Attendance in academic events, such as seminar, lab work, workshop or a skills development program, may be adjusted to cover the shortage in a given course. It is the responsibility of the students to constantly monitor their attendance level.

b. Examination and Student Evaluation

The students' performance would be evaluated through subjective and objective methods including quizzes, presentations (individual and group), group discussions, case studies and project assignments/lab reports in addition to mid-term and final examinations. These assessment marks (to be determined by the faculty member concerned) will have different weightage contributing towards the overall assessment in percentage marks. This weightage will be determined on the basis of the following guidelines:

- Quizzes/Assignments/ Presentations/Attendances 20%
- Mid-term Examination 20%
- Final Examination 60%

The Grade Point Average (GPA) is computed as follows:

c. Freezing of Program

A student may be allowed to freeze a program if he / she is not able to continue under Force Majeure. However, this option can only be exercised subject to the following conditions:

- i. Semester freezing will be granted by the Semester Committee upon recommendation of the program coordinator in response to the request made by the student with cogent and plausible reasons.
- ii. If a student freezes a semester, he/ she will resume his studies from the same stage where he/she left (froze).
- iii. The maximum duration of the degree program as stipulated in these rules shall remain the same.
- iv. Freeze semester shall be counted towards the duration of the program.
- v. The option of semester freezing will only be exercised after the completion of first semester.
- vi. The students on probation are not eligible for freezing of programs.

d. Degree Time Period

Al- Taqwa Institute of Higher Education offers its undergraduate degree in business administration over completion of 148 credit as per requirement of Ministry of Higher Education of Afghanistan. This includes courses in five main categories; general education, foundation, core, electives and thesis. Generally Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) is a 4-year degree program, the overall degree is divided into eight semesters and/or four years of study with 17 to 21 credits of courses in each regular semester. Each credit hour is equal to 16 sessions per semester. The maximum duration of obtaining BBA degree is six years.

Scholarships and Financial Assistance

Following the university's commitment to providing quality education, the scholarship and Financial Assistance platform is designed to empower eligible students with confirmed financial needs or extraordinary academic, public service, and sporting accomplishments to follow higher education with Al-Taqwa University. This program aims to support current and prospective students to attain academic excellence at the university.

Financial assistance is offered in tuition fee discounts to reduce the financial burden on students. Financial assistance awards are determined by the Al-Taqwa University scholarship and financial assistance committee at the beginning of each semester.

Al-Taqwa University is committed to ensuring all students have equal access to scholarship and financial assistance programs. The university reviews the application in the following way:

- Submission of application: students submit their request and all supporting documents to their relevant departments by the identified deadline.
- Review of application: a review of applications is conducted by the respective deans of the applicant's chosen program of study, and nominations for the award are submitted to the VC-Academics for final selection.
- Selection & notification of decision: VC-Academics conducts the final selection, and students are notified of the decision on their applications for the scholarship through student portals

Al-Taqwa University is committed to identifying students' academic achievements and extracurricular activities, which will motivate and encourage students to work hard towards further accomplishments.

These accomplishments are rewarded with different scholarships detailed in the following divisions. The university is also committed to ensuring no student is left behind from pursuing higher education solely for financial reasons.

Types of Scholarships

Merit Based Scholarships

Al-Taqwa offers merit-based scholarships to students of undergraduate and graduate programs who are in excellent academic and disciplinary standings. Scholarships are awarded at the beginning of spring and fall semesters and are valid only for one semester.

- Candidates with a minimum of 75% attendance in previous semester.
- Candidates attaining a minimum of 4.00 Grade Point Average (GPA) in the previous semester and a minimum of 3.8 Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).
- Candidates with active participation in community engagement activities are preferred.

Athletic Scholarships and Financial Assistance

Sports play important role in the mental and physical well-being of students. Apart from academic achievements, Al-Taqwa University admires sporting activities and has allocated generous scholarships and financial assistance to these extra-curricular activities of sports. Those students who have active roles in sporting activities within clubs, and have vital achievements will receive scholarships and financial assistance from Al-Taqwa University.

Eligibility Criteria

- Having a minimum of 75% attendance in the previous semester
- Attaining a minimum of 3.0 GPA during the last semester
- Active membership in a AL-Taqwa University student club
- Demonstrating participation in student activities and events

Co and Extracurricular Activities Scholarships

Co-curricular activities are the ones that come along with curriculum. Extra-curricular activities are not part of the curriculum such as debates, competitions and student expo. Students who may have outstanding or extra ordinary achievements, extracurricular or class activities would be considered for a scholarship award. The nature of this scholarship varies with the passage of time.

Eligibility Criteria

- Having a minimum of 75% attendance in the previous semester
- Attaining a minimum of 3.0 GPA during the last semester
- Active membership in a Al-Taqwa University student club
- Demonstrating participation in student activities and events




